



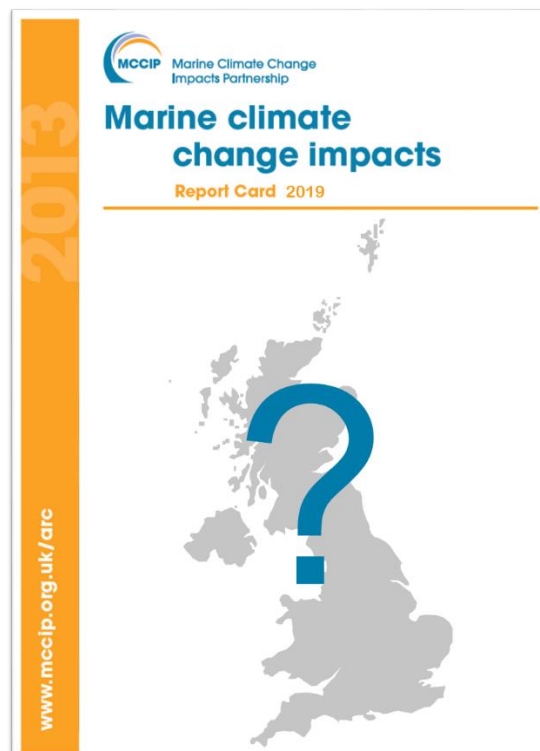
## Marine Climate Change Impacts Partnership
